ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Adopted by the YAO Board on April 7, 2011

Dear Parent/Player,

Players and Coaches of YAO Baseball Bermuda ("YAO") you are expected to maintain a high standard of conduct and sportsmanship. The throwing of equipment, foul and abusive language, taunting or gestures and disrespect will not be tolerated. Therefore, the YAO Board of Directors has deemed it necessary to implement a "Zero Tolerance" policy in regards to these issues.

If a Player is found to have committed one of these acts, the Umpire will have the authority to immediately eject the player from that particular game.

If a Player is found to have committed one of these acts for a second time, then the Player will be subject to appear in front of the YAO Executive Board and will be suspended for up to three (3) games, but not less than one (1) game.

If a Player is found to have committed one of these acts for a third time, then the Player will be expelled from the League for the remainder of the season. There will be no refund for such behavior.

Coaches will be held just as accountable, if not more so, than the Players. If a Coach is found to have committed one of these acts, it is the responsibility of the Player, Parent, other Coach or Board Member to inform the Executive Board and the Coach will be dealt with accordingly.

It is the YAO Board of Directors desire to provide a safe and fun environment for each and every Player that participates in this League. Your understanding and cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
